APPLICATIONS FOR PRACTISING CERTIFICATES

Since March 2000, applications for practising certificates may be made electronically via the Practising Certificate Electronic Filing System ("PC E-filing System") on the Supreme Court Internet website (<http://www.supcourt.gov.sg>). Further enhancements have since been made to the PC E-filing System, including an additional mode of payment of the application fee through the law firm's Interbank GIRO account with the Supreme Court.

2 This practice direction is accordingly issued by the Registrar pursuant to Rule 4 of the Legal Profession (Practising Certificate) Rules under the direction of the Honourable the Chief Justice to reflect the above enhancements to the system.

3 This practice direction will come into effect on 19 Feb 2002.
