## PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 2 OF 2002

## EXTENSION OF ELECTRONIC FILING TO OTHER PROCEEDINGS AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS

With effect from 28 May 2002, the Electronic Filing Service ("EFS") will extend to the following proceedings:

- (1) companies winding up petitions;
- (2) admiralty proceedings;
- (3) originating motions;
- (4) originating petitions;
- (5) petitions of course;
- (6) bankruptcy proceedings;
- (7) petitions for grant of probate and letters of administration; and
- (8) power of attorney.

2. This practice direction sets out the procedure to be complied with in respect of the above proceedings as well as other miscellaneous changes to paragraphs 43YA and 65.

3. This practice direction shall come into effect on 28 May 2002.

4. This practice direction should be included in *The Supreme Court Practice Directions (1997 Ed.)* immediately before the first page of the table of contents. The instructions for effecting the amendments to *The Supreme Court Practice Directions* (1997 Ed.) are contained in the Appendix hereto.
