Part IV: Interlocutory Applications

42. *Mareva* injunctions and search orders

(1) Pursuant to Order 32, Rule 9 of the Rules of Court, the Honourable the Chief Justice has directed that **unless otherwise directed, contested** applications for *Mareva* injunctions and **applications** for search orders, whether made on an *ex parte* or *inter partes* basis, should be heard by a Judge in person. ~~For the avoidance of doubt, and~~ all other *ex parte* applications for interim injunctions may be heard by a Registrar.
