DEMISE OF MR LAI KEW CHAI – MINUTE OF SILENCE JUDGE (1981 – 2006)

Mr Lai Kew Chai, Judge of the Supreme Court from 1 July 1981 to 6 February 2006 passed away peacefully at 11:36 am on 27 February 2006. Mr Lai was born in Perak on 7 February 1941. He read law at the then University of Singapore and graduated in 1966. He was admitted to the Singapore Bar that same year. From 1977 to 1981, he was the Director of the Postgraduate Practical Law Course and a member of the Military Court of Appeal. From 1 October 1981 to 7 March 1993, he was the Chairman of the Board of Legal Education. He was elected to the Council of the Law Society in 1979 and elected Vice-President of the Law Society for 1980 and 1981.

- After his appointment to the Supreme Court Bench, he was appointed a Senate Member and Executive Committee Member of the Singapore Academy of Law since 1989. He was also appointed Chairman of the Legal Education and Studies Committee, Singapore Academy of Law from 19 January 1989 to 28 July 1995 and Chairman of the Professional Affairs Committee, Singapore Academy of Law from 24 July 1993 until 6 February 2006.
