2019) FOR THE PERIOD FROM 5 MAY 2020 TO 1 JUNE 2020

On 21 April 2020, the Ministry of Health issued a press release entitled "Strong

National Push to Stem Spread of COVID-19" announcing the extension of the circuit breaker

period to further reduce transmission of COVID-19. In view of this press release, the Relevant

Period mentioned in Registrar's Circular No. 4 of 2020¹ will be extended by 4 weeks until (and

inclusive of) 1 June 2020. For the avoidance of doubt, Registrar's Circular No. 4 of 2020 will

continue to apply during the entire extension of the Relevant Period.

We will continue to monitor the situation. All court users and visitors are advised to

information and updates.
