REGISTRAR'S CIRCULAR NO. 5 OF 2020

UPDATES ON MEASURES RELATING TO COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019) FOR THE PERIOD FROM 5 MAY 2020 TO 1 JUNE 2020

On 21 April 2020, the Ministry of Health issued a press release entitled “Strong National Push to Stem Spread of COVID-19” announcing the extension of the circuit breaker period to further reduce transmission of COVID-19. In view of this press release, the Relevant Period mentioned in Registrar’s Circular No. 4 of 2020¹ will be extended by 4 weeks until (and inclusive of) 1 June 2020. For the avoidance of doubt, Registrar’s Circular No. 4 of 2020 will continue to apply during the entire extension of the Relevant Period.
