## (I) Introduction

Parties involved in bankruptcy hearings are required to register their attendance and take their queue numbers at the Centralised Display Management System (CDMS) Self-service Kiosks. When your case is ready to be heard, the queue-calling panels will chime and your queue number will be displayed in red on the queuecalling panels. Please sit at the waiting area at Level 2 where the queue-calling panels are located. Your case will be heard by an Assistant Registrar in one of the bankruptcy hearing chambers located on Level 2.

The bankruptcy hearing chambers (denoted by  $\blacksquare$ ) and 3 queue-calling panels (denoted by  $\blacklozenge$ ) are located on level 2.
