SUPREME COURT PRACTICE DIRECTIONS 2021

To cater for the changes made by the Rules of Court 2021, a new edition of the Supreme Court Practice Directions (called the “Supreme Court Practice Directions 2021”) will come into operation at the same time as the Rules of Court 2021 on 1 April 2022.

2 The Supreme Court Practice Directions 2021 are to be read with the Rules of Court 2021, and will apply on and after 1 April 2022 to:

- (a) any cause or matter, in the General Division of the High Court, the Appellate Division of the High Court or the Court of Appeal, that is governed by the Rules of Court 2021; and
- (b) any criminal proceedings commenced, in the General Division of the High Court or the Court of Appeal, on or after 1 April 2022.

3 The existing Supreme Court Practice Directions will continue to apply, on and after 1 April 2022, to:

- (a) any cause or matter, in the General Division of the High Court, the Appellate Division of the High Court or the Court of Appeal, that is governed by the existing Rules of Court (Cap. 322, R 5, 2014 Ed.); and
- (b) any criminal proceedings commenced, in the General Division of the High Court or the Court of Appeal, before 1 April 2022.
