CONSOLIDATING OUR CHANGES



Strengthening Dispute Resolution Frameworks



Family Justice
The recommendations by the inter-agency Committee to Review and Enhance Reforms in the Family Justice System will further strengthen the family justice framework.



Civil Justice
The recommendations by the Civil Justice Commission and the Civil Justice Review Committee, released for public consultation in October 2018, aim to improve the civil justice system.



Criminal Justice
Empanelling of three-Judge benches for Magistrates' Appeals and issuance of guideline judgments have enriched Singapore's sentencing jurisprudence and the Criminal Justice Reform Act enacted in 2018 will strengthen the criminal justice framework.



Fortifying International Ties and Partnerships



Deepening engagement with ASEAN through regular meetings.



Strengthening ties with China's Supreme People's Court through the annual Singapore-China Legal and Judicial Roundtable.



Fortified relations with other judiciaries through active participation in, and hosting of, international meetings.



Appointments of Singapore Judges in overseas courts reflect the growing international standing of our Judges.
