Availability of Divorce eService

The Judiciary has provided an electronic service which can be used both by lawyers and litigants in person.

If a lay-person uses the eService, s/he is able to fill in details relevant to an intended divorce application, but s/he is also able to stop and "handover" the in-progress application for a lawyer to "take over". This may be appropriate where the intended applicant feels that s/he needs the services of a lawyer to deal with various aspects of the application.

The rest of this brief document sets out what a lawyer should do, if an individual approaches you with information about a partially-filled divorce application, and asks that you "take over" the electronic application.
